- 1. The CCA Nurse, in collaboration with the interdisciplinary team, will be responsible for the care of intensive care patients (medical, cardiac, surgical, & pulmonary) and participate in inpatient care.
- 2. Provide clinical care to patients referred for Intensive Care, in coordination with the attending physician including appropriate history & documentation of consultation Care.
- 3. Ability & willingness to learn about critical care diseases including diagnosis and management.
- 4. Assist physicians in prescribing/ordering appropriate pharmacologic & non-pharmacologic interventions & develop a treatment plan.
- 5. Follow unit-specific protocols & deliver evidence-based care.
- 6. Explain medical procedures & plan of care to patients & families in the presence of a physician. Participate in teaching rounds, conferences, quality assurance programs & chart reviews.
- 7. Assignments will also include rotation to bedside hospitals as needed. Other responsibilities include but are not limited to Providing comprehensive care for critically ill patients in the smart ICU including, but not limited to, obtaining accurate patient history, performing complete physical exams, systematically ordering & interpreting diagnostic tests, & accurately documenting findings in the electronic medical record.
